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#### INTRODUCTION

In this installation guide we have provided step by step instructions to install the 27WON Performance Front Strut Tower Bar.

#### **Advisory:**

- The engine bay will be hot after recent vehicle operation. Allow the vehicle to cool or use a fan to cool the engine bay before working on the vehicle.
- When disconnecting a battery, always disconnect the negative battery terminal first and be careful with the use of metal tools.



### Step 1 — Getting Started

- These instructions were written with a 2018 Civic Type R and 2018 Honda Civic SI. Other models will be similar

## Step 2 — Locate Strut Tower Tops







- Locate the strut tower tops in the engine bay
- Shown are the passenger and driver side strut tower tops. Some vehicle models and varying years have a black metal plate on the strut top and some do not. This black metal plate is not retained

#### Step 3 — Battery Cable Install: Non-Type R Only







- i This step is only necessary for Non-Type R vehicles. If you have a Type R then you can skip this step. Example was performed on a 2018 Honda Civic SI
  - Disconnect the negative battery cable by loosening the 10mm nut (red circle), with a wrench or a
    10mm socket and ratchet, and remove it from the terminal
- Remove the OEM ground battery cable (blue circles) by unbolting the 10mm bolt and nut (blue circles) with a wrench or 10mm socket and ratchet
- Attach the provided ground battery cable
  - (i) Both brackets have tabs that fixes them in the correct orientations
- Start threading the 10mm bolt and nut (orange circles) by hand, tighten down with a wrench or 10mm socket and ratchet
- Reattach the negative battery cable to the terminal (green circle) and tighten 10mm nut with wrench or 10mm socket and ratchet

#### Step 4 — Remove Passenger Side Strut Hardware







- Remove three (3) flange nuts with a 14mm deep socket and ratchet wrench
- If equipped, remove the black metal plate
  - (i) This black metal plate is not reused with the 27WON Strut Bar
- Clean any debris from the strut top surface

#### Step 5 — Remove Driver Side Strut Hardware







- Remove three (3) flange nuts with a 14mm deep socket and ratchet wrench
- If equipped, remove the black metal plate
  - This black metal plate is not reused with the 27WON Strut Bar
- Clean any debris from the strut top surface

# Step 6 — Install 27WON Strut Bar






- Orientate the strut bar so the center section is forward as shown
- Place each end of the strut bar down on the strut tops over the studs
- (i) Raw color is used only for install instruction, actual color may vary

## Step 7 — Verify Battery Cable Clearance



- The strut bar sits very close to the battery cable, please verify the cables are not pushing up into the strut bar
- if the cables are pushing into the strut bar, adjust the cables by flexing them downward a bit to create clearance
- The battery cables are insulated and protected by a plastic jacket but minimizing contact with the bar is preferred

## **Step 8** — **Fasten Passenger Side of Strut Bar**



- Install the three (3) OEM flange nuts
- Using a torque wrench and 14mm socket, torque each to 45-47 lb-ft

- Install the three (3) OEM flange nuts
- Using a torque wrench and 14mm socket, torque each to 45-47 lb-ft


# Step 10 — Install the Optional Brake Brace
